



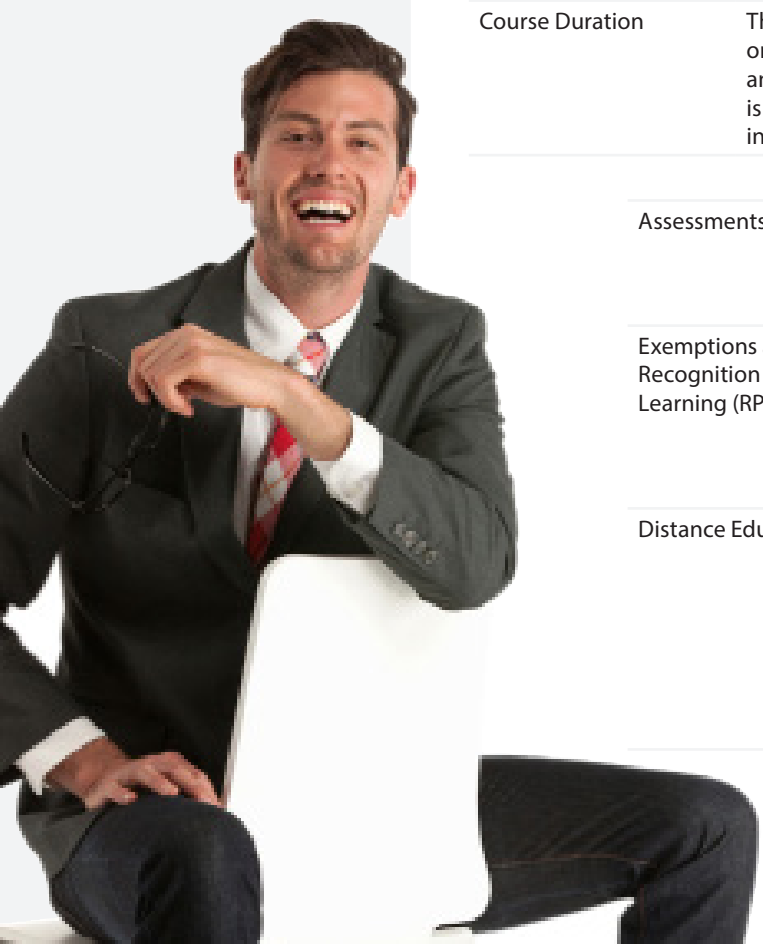

FNS50215 Diploma of Accounting

A FNS50215 Diploma of Accounting will give you the knowledge you need to provide professional advice and boost your career in the competitive accounting industry. This course will equip you with a broad range of Accounting skills via a combination of written and skill assessments. Covering both financial and tax implications in business as well as personal finance skills to manage household budgets and Tax returns.

Completing a FNS50215 Diploma of Accounting will enable you to work in many different Accounting roles including Accounts manager, Officer in Accounting, Assistant Accountant, Company Bookkeeper, Supervisor of Accounts Department and Budget Officer or Planner. The FNS50215 Diploma of Accounting is available as Government Funded for eligible students.

This course covers the following TWO modules:

Principles of Accounting in Practice (PAP)

Provides students with an Introduction to Financial Accounting, The Recording System, Corporate Governance and Control Systems, an Introduction to Management Accounting, and Management Accounting Techniques.

Fundamentals of Accounting in Practice (FAP)

Provides students with an Introduction to the Accounting Profession, Accounting, Business and Financial Terminology and Accounting Systems, Payroll, Small Business, GST issues and Budgeting.
