

Using a student edition of AccountRight, our program goes through a business, Child's Play, and their activities for the month of July 2014.

This course is designed to help those running their books for their own company, or an accountant or bookkeeper working for specific businesses. It will assist you in learning how to enter daily financial transactions into the Sales Purchases and Banking Command Centres.
